Several new initiatives and partnerships were highlights of 2018-19. The Higher Powered Learning Program, a project with the University of Notre Dame, is helping us

to individualize learning by combining traditional

classroom work with online and group study components. The results in our pilot classrooms at Ascension and St. John Paul II schools were astounding. For example: 7th graders at JPII made 21/4 years of growth in reading and 11/2 years in math in one school year.

At St. Peter Claver, our partnership with Groves Academy is helping us more effectively teach literacy, and it shows: Our 2nd graders advanced in reading at more than double the national average.





How has the education you received at Ascension guided your life personally and professionally?

The education at Ascension was top-notch. More important, were the intangibles I gained at Ascension: How to communicate effectively, how to work as a team, and how faith can carry you a long way. My immediate siblings and I all graduated from Ascension, and the caring adults, mentors, and lifelong friends we gained are immeasurable.

What is special about Ascension and the other Academy schools?

They steer a scholar's moral compass to be more compassionate, empathic and responsible and teach them to lead with integrity. These intangibles, combined with an education that is personalized and rigorous, provide scholars with a leg up compared with other schools. They produce high-caliber, emotionally intelligent students on their way to better our society.

I believe in the scholars and their families, I trust the leadership and staff, and I know that life isn't about what you get but it's about what you give.

How would young alum like you benefit from getting involved?

Knowing you're helping a scholar, a family, on their journey to a successful future is a great feeling. Also, volunteering provides you a new network of leaders in your community to learn from and engage with. These individuals will recognize your commitment and ultimately help you achieve your goals professionally and personally. I would encourage all alum to give something, whether that's time, money, or talent. I know all the schools could use it. I would also remind folks that every little bit counts. Nothing you give is too big or too small.





'I love seeing the light-bulb moments'

When Twink LaFave heard that St. Peter Claver Catholic School needed tutors, she thought, "I can do that." She figured raising four children gave her the qualifications. "I treat them like I treated my own kids," she said. Over the past three years, she has helped in the kindergarten classroom, and she has read and tutored in the after-school program.

What moment stands out for you in all your time volunteering?

One day it was raining when I arrived. The scholars were on the playground, and a 5th grader ran over and said, "You can have my coat." The girl took off her coat and held it over my head. She was soaked by the time we got to the door, but she wanted to keep me dry.

What's it like volunteering at St. Peter Claver?

It's something totally other than my regular life. Being here is totally different from what I normally do. It's like fly fishing in a Wisconsin stream. I can forget everything and be totally engrossed.
