## PLANS FOR THE COMING YEAR

- **Kindergarten, First, and Second grades** will have the option to be in the school building or to learn remotely. We are opening the building to these scholars because of the foundational learning that happens in early grades.
- **Grades 3 to 8** will be fully distanced through at least the first trimester.
- **Distance learning will be more rigorous**, with increased hours of direct instruction, more opportunities for prayer as a school community, and increased incorporation of social/emotional learning. Teachers will teach from their classrooms.
- **Academy teachers will assess scholars** before units of study so gaps in skills can be addressed and support given to scholars who need it.



## OTHER NEEDS FOR FAMILIES

- From the beginning of the pandemic, we have assisted families with access to technology, food security, and other needs. We plan to continue this effort, addressing access to meals for all scholars, providing each scholar with a Chromebook and ensuring families have Internet access.



## OUR BUDGET

- While most scholars may not be in our school buildings, the Ascension Catholic Academy budget remains the same. **Our budget for 2020-2021 is \$6.6 million. More than 80% of this comes from supporters like you.**
- Distance learning has increased expenses for items such as devices for all scholars, educational software, and streaming services that allow teachers to provide live online instruction.
- As always, **the largest portion of our budget is paying staff to teach these wonderful scholars. And, as always, we cannot do this work without you. Thank you!**
